Amherst Athletic Association Rookie League Rules

Goals: To teach the game, develop skills, & have fun!

I. Field

- 1. Bases 60ft
- 2. Pitching rubber 35ft
- 3. Pitching circle 8' radius, 16' diameter

II. Equipment

- 1. Batting Helmets with face masks are required
- 2. 11" soft core softball
- 3. ASA sanctioned fastpitch softball bat
- Catchers must wear full catchers gear
 (helmet w/ mask, chest protector, shin guards)
- 5. No metal cleats

III. Game

- 1. Time 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ hours with no new inning starting after 1 hr 20 mins, if you start a new inning both teams are entitled to bat unless it is not necessary based on score.
 - 2. Base coaches and pitching coach will umpire the game
 - 3. Official game after 4 innings or 3 ½ innings if home team is winning
 - 4. The winning team will report the score
 - 5. If game is stopped before it is an official game, the game will resume from where it left off
 - 6. Batting line up is exchanged before the start of the game
 - 7. Continuous batting order- every player bats even if they do not play the field
 - 8. 5 run limit per inning
 - 9. 10 players in the field with 4 outfielders
 - 10. Minimum players a team can play with is 8 players. If a team falls below the 8 players that team forfeits.
 - 11. You may borrow a player from another team in the league but they must bat last and can only play in the outfield.
 - 12. Please be mindful if there is another game immediately after yours. Please clear the dugouts and then have your post game team meeting.

IV. Batting

- 1. Every batter gets a max of 5 pitches to put the ball in play (no balls or strikes)
- 2. No bunting, stealing, lead offs, walks, or hit by pitch
- 3. Baserunners may attempt to advance one base on an overthrow when ball is put in play
- 4. Late arrivals are placed at the end of the batting order
- 5. No penalty of an out if a team has less than 10 batters. No penalty of an out if a player has to leave the game.

V. Fielding

- 1. Players cannot sit 2 consecutive innings unless they are ill, injured, restroom or for disciplinary reasons
- 2. Players may not play the same position more than 2 times in a game
- 3. Every player must play in the outfield at least one inning and in the infield at least one inning.
- 4. Coach or adult volunteer will pitch from inside the pitching circle with one foot on the rubber.
- 5. The player in the pitching position should be inside the circle to the left or right of the coach pitching.
- 6. The 4 outfielders should be in the grass or at an agreed upon distance from the grass when playing on a bigger field.
- 7. The play is stopped when the ball is secured in the infield. If a base runner has already made the turn to the next base they can continue to run to the next base.
- 8. If the ball hits the coach the play is dead, players get next base
- 9. 2 coaches may stand in the outfield to instruct the fielders for the first 2 weeks of the season only.
- 10. Coaches cannot touch a player or the ball to assist in the play.
- 11. No infield fly rule
- 12. Double plays are allowed and encouraged
